NAPLAN NATIONAL ASSESSMENT PROGRAM Literacy and Numeracy

Earlier this year our Year 3 and Year 5 students completed **NAPLAN** Online. The online tests provide an indication of student knowledge and skills in Reading, Writing, Language Conventions (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and Numeracy.

It is important to understand that, in terms of individual student performances, NAPLAN is a 'snapshot' of performance on a particular day. At SMMPS there are many other ways in which we report student progress, this may be through Seesaw, Learning Conversations or Formal Reports. As a school we analyse each year's NAPLAN data and use this to inform future teaching and support student learning.

NAPLAN results will be mailed out to families this week. The report will show how your child performed in relation to national minimum standards for students across Australia.


