
### Writing

Students move through the steps in the writing process to compose written pieces that entertain and persuade. They will have opportunities to develop the craft of writing, as well as, build on organisational structures, such as paragraphs and the correct use of punctuation. Students will be exposed to various spelling strategies and grammatical structures to enhance their writing.

# Number

Students will develop their understanding of place value with numbers up to four digits. They will skip count by 2, 3, 5, and 10 from various starting points. Students will investigate strategies that can be applied when adding and subtracting numbers.


**Mathematics**

opportunities, attend mass in their class groups and develop Catholic meditation routines.






Speaking and Listening Students will be encouraged to listen and contribute to conversations and discussions when sharing information and ideas.
