Over the years we have had much to celebrate. We remember and with pride the day, on Sunday 17 October 2010, that Mary MacKillop was recognised and canonized by Pope Benedict, as Australia's First Saint.

We are certainly proud of the fact that we are a school in her name and under her care. Thus, on 17 October 2010, our school's name was officially changed to St. Mary MacKillop Primary School.



The school community of 2010 gathered, with Monsignor Portelli and the then Archbishop of Melbourne, Denis Hart, celebrating Mary's canonisation; at which time we unveiled the statue on the front path.

I am proud to have led this school, as Principal, for 17 years, together with a wonderful team of staff, parents and children supporting our efforts to create the best learning and teaching environment possible for all our children.

To enhance and improve our school environment; we had work completed over January. We have recarpeted Fitzroy and John Paul 11. New carpets promote pride and provide the children with a cleaner and more attractive classrooms. We have also installed vinyl in common areas of these areas. This floor surface is so much more practical for a wide variety of activities.





We have also artificially turfed over the asphalt adjacent to the new building. This is a much cleaner and safer surface for the children to sit on for Assembly. It is also an ideal surface for Phys. Ed lessons to occur on and other outdoor lessons. I also notice the kids really enjoy playing on this surface at recesses.



There is more artificial turf to be laid behind Tension Woods, to alleviate a problem area where grass will not grow.

OSHC is now located in the double portable. It is an excellent facility, providing the children with indoor and outdoor spaces, all within line of sight, making for a safer and more engaging program.
